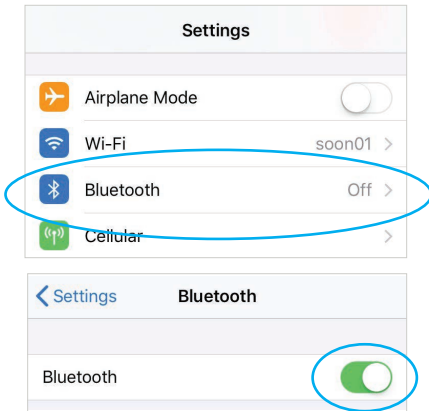


Connecting Moxi All and Moxi All R to your cell phone

1 Bluetooth menu

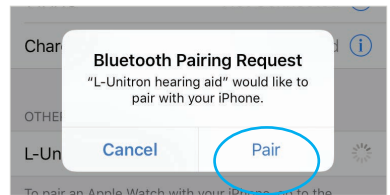
Open the Bluetooth® menu on your phone (often found in “Settings” or “Tools”). Make sure Bluetooth is on.



2 Pairing

Your hearing aid name:

Open and close the battery door on the (R or L) hearing aid. The name of your hearing aid will appear on the phone. Tap on it to select, and click “pair” if prompted.



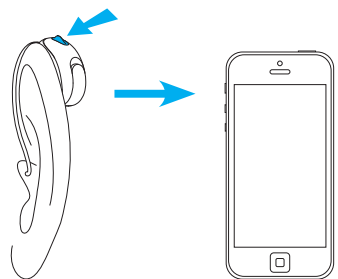
3 Phone calls

The microphones on the hearing aid pick up your voice so you can be hands-free. Just push either hearing aid button to accept or reject the call. **Short push to accept <2 seconds. Long push to reject >2 seconds.**



4 Adjust

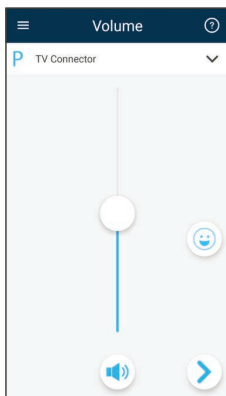
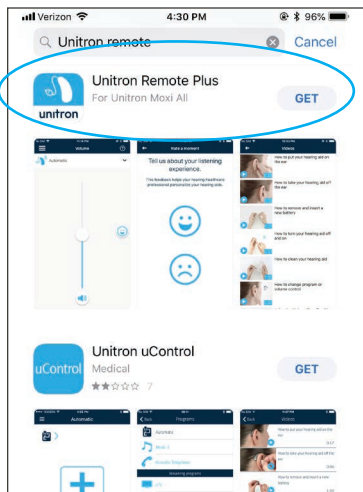
You can increase the phone call volume by pushing the R hearing aid button, and decrease the volume by pushing the L hearing aid button. This can also be done with the volume buttons on the side of your phone.



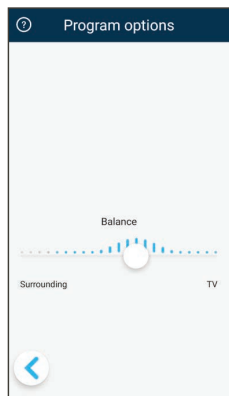
Download the Unitron Remote Plus app
